

### John 3:16

"For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."

This verse is probably one of the most memorized, recognized, and seen Bible verses. It's been publicly displayed on billboards on the side of the road and posters at sporting events. It's powerful yet precious; the perfect summary of the Gospel. It explains the entire Bible in one sentence. God's powerful and unfailing love for the world was bought by Jesus' death on the cross and the precious gift of salvation was given to any who believe [and continue to believe] in Him.

LUMINtruth is focused on adults AND children learning and understanding scripture. To hear from our younger readers, we asked a bible study group of middle schoolers what this verse means to them:

"This verse means a lot of things to me. God's love for us is WILD. No matter how badly we sin His love is still immeasurable. Life would be SO different (terrible) without God sending Jesus down. We would not go to heaven - What?! Eternal life is a dream. You best believe I'm coming to see my heavenly Father.
